

Beyond “Dragon and Elephant” – Assessment of China and India’s Economic Growth

Professor Pranab Bardhan is Professor of Economics at University of California, Berkley and will speak on *The Rise of China and India: A Comparative Economic Assessment* at University of Melbourne next Thursday.

Professor Bardhan is one of the world’s foremost development economists and has spoken extensively around the world. In South Africa he has delivered the ILO Noble Peace Prize Lecture entitled "Social Justice in the Global Economy".

As China and India continues to attract global media attention on the success of their economic growth, Professor Bardhan calls for a more comprehensive understanding by investigating not only what meets the eye but “their broad development and their approaches to economic reform.”
