FIGHT FOR RICE PROJECT

FFR stands for Fight For Rice

Over the past 10 years, I have been involved in the Daging Tumbuh collective which publishes a series of limited edition, independent comic zines. At the same time, I have also been working together with other artists and artist groups from Indonesia who make art merchandise for sale.

Fight For Rice (FFR) was born out of the need to create a micro-economy after a major economic crisis. Adopting the 'distro model' (an independent outlet that is more connected and responsive to the maker/merchandise) in a little shop with products made by artists, Fight For Rice (FFR) is a way of creating an artist support system to generate a steady amount of income and ensure that we are able to continue to create works and to survive since there is no public funding for the arts in Indonesia.
